Carbon Capture Programme (The Woodland Trust)

In partnership with the Woodland Trust & Premier Paper Group, Thomson Print & Packaging are delighted to announce that we have joined the Carbon Capture® Program.

Through the Woodland Trust's Government backed Woodland Carbon Scheme, CO2 is captured by the planting of trees in new native woodland here in the UK.

A small Carbon Capture® charge is applied to all our stock materials, ordered through Premier Paper Group.

100% of the Carbon Capture charge goes directly to the Woodland Trust to plant native woodland in the UK.

A Woodland Carbon Capture® logo with a unique reference number will be provided for use on any marketing material and print media where Carbon Capture® material has been used as well as any web communications.

The Woodland Carbon logo and the Carbon Capture® term can only be used in conjunction with purchases from the Premier Paper Group and where a Carbon Capture® charge has been made.

Papers with recycled content (GF Smith UK)

In partnership with GF Smith, we can offer our customers a range of different papers than contain recycled content.

We have papers available that range from 35%-100% recycled content.

Papers with recycled content (Fedrigoni UK)

In partnership with Fedrigoni UK, we can offer our customers a range of different papers than contain recycled content.

We have papers available that range from 25%-100% recycled content.

Sample sheets can be supplied upon request.

Additional Accreditations/Information

All the paper and boards we use hold FSC/ ECF or PEFC Certifications.

Other certifications include Green Star System & EU Ecolabel Accreditation.

All paper and boards used have 100% recyclability.

Our carton board has a life cycle of 7 cycles. After this, the remaining fibres can be compressed into making bricks for construction.



Inks & Printing Consumables

All the inks/varnishes we use are recyclable.

Offset printing inks and varnishes are not an obstacle for the recycling of printed paper and board. The recycling process often includes a de-inking step to remove the ink particles from the fibrous material by flotation or washing. Offset printing inks and varnishes have been optimised over many years regarding proper de-inkability.

Our supplier works closely with organisations such as Cradle to Cradle, CEFLEX, INGEDE & EPEA to further increase sustainability in the printing industry.



They also ensure that the CO2 footprint of their products is kept as low as possible and favour printing ink components that are recyclable or compostable.

Foil

All the foils we use are compostable, recyclable, biodegradable & repulplable.

Apart from one foil reference in the range that uses beeswax, all the foils are vegan.

Our supplier operates on a Zero 2 Landfill basis, therefore, they covert their waste to solid recovered fuel (SRF) to be used in the cement industry. This is used as a replacement for fossil fuels such as coal.

In addition, they are certified ISO 14001 (Environmental management standard).



Gluing

Thomson Print & Packaging purchase the glue for their carton production through Henkel UK, one of the most sustainable suppliers of water-based adhesives on the market.

Henkel aim to contribute to solving global challenges through material science and know-how in bonding, sealing, and coating.

Furthermore, they drive systematic change in the areas of climate,

circularity and safety through products and partnerships.

Referring to packaging specifically, glue coverage is estimated at under 10% per product and can be removed fully during the recycling process.

Henkels glues are optimised for removal during the recycling process, contributing to a fully recyclable product.



Additional Materials (String)

Thomson Print & Packaging offer range of string made from recycled or biodegradable materials.

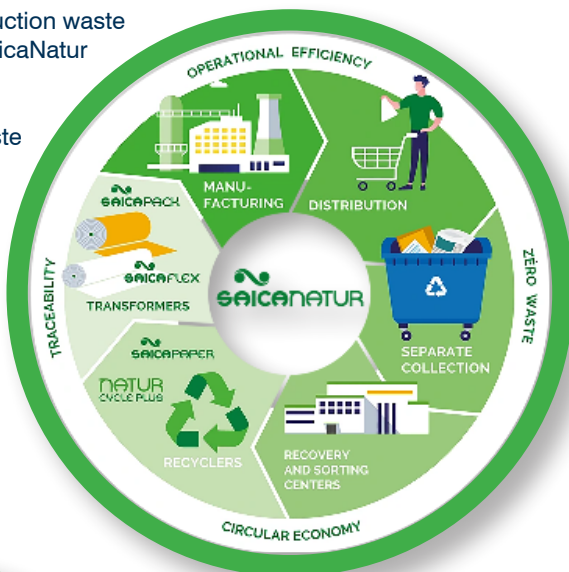
80% of our supplier's waste is re-used for new production materials.



Paper/Board Waste Management (SaicaNatur UK)

100% of our paper/board production waste is sent for recycling through SaicaNatur UK.

100% of our foil production waste is sent for recycling through SaicaNatur UK as part of the Zero foil 2 Landfill scheme.



Chemical Waste Management

We use reusable printing cloths (no landfill).

We dispose of our print chemical waste responsibly. Our waste management company are certified ISO 14001 (Environmental Standard)

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
